
# Five-Year Plan

The plan graphic at left illustrates the capital projects targeted for the next five years. These include a mix of buildings constructed anew, existing ones adapted to new purposes and improvements to parking areas, open spaces and bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

# **Buildings**

## **Randy Owen Center**

New 61,000 sf performing arts center and outdoor amphitheater to be opened in 2024

## **Student Housing and Athletics Facilities**

New 350-bed housing development together with a new dining hall and various facilities for the football program to be completed in 2024

# **Band Storage and Storm Shelter**

16,000 sf marching band storage facility adjacent to Bennett Field will include JSU's primary storm shelter





## **Football Practice Field**

Existing football practice field will be relocated adjacent to Burgess Snow Stadium

# First Year Housing Phase 1

350 beds in two new first-year dormitory buildings located on the former sites of Glazner and Luttrell Halls

# **Upper Class Housing**

300-500 beds in residential village oriented around a central green adjacent to the athletics complex

### **President's House**

Construction of new President's residence on 11th Street

#### Alumni House

Adaptive reuse of the existing President's House to accommodate Alumni Relations for office and events uses

# Renovations

## Cole Center

Interior modifications to convert the Jack Hopper Cafeteria into a student meeting facility

## College of Education

Improvements to relocate the College of Education into the former Kitty Stone Elementary School, previously occupied by the College of Business and Industry

## Ramona Wood Hall

Renovations to the existing building to accommodate new academic use (multiple departments within the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences) as College of Education relocates to the Kitty Stone complex

# **South Campus**

Completion of onoing renovations and retrofit of the north wing for simulation center

# **Houston Cole Library**

Building-wide interiors updates, technology and other improvements to create flexible, cutting-edge spaces for individual study and collaboration

#### First Year Residence Halls

HVAC and other upgrades to Crow and Dixon Halls

# **Open Space**

#### TMB Lawn

In conjunction with consolidation of the adjacent parking lots, the current lawn will be enlarged and improved with seating, walkways and other amenities

# **Merrill Courtyard**

Construction of planned outdoor gathering space at Merrill Hall

## The Quad

Update to the central quad including new seating options, charging stations and other improvements

## **South Campus**

Construction of outdoor space as part of ongoing renovation



# **Parking**

## **Pelham Road**

Multiple small parking areas will be consolidated to increase capacity with landscaping provided along Pelham Road

### Softball

Expansion of existing parking area adjacent to Wallace Hall for softball use

## **Longleaf Studios**

Construction of additional parking on west side of building

# **Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities**

# Highway 21 and 204 improvements

Modifications to the intersection of Highways 21 and 204 for pedestrian crossing safety, including a speed table in the southwest quadrant and sight distance improvements for motorists; pedestrian refuges at mid-block crossings

# **West Campus Shared Path Phase 1**

Shared bicycle-pedestrian path from Forney Avenue to the Chief Ladiga Trail at Paul Carpenter Village



# **Goodlett Avenue Shared Path**

Shared bicycle-pedestrian path along east side of Goodlett Avenue from Mountain Street to the Kitty Stone complex

## **Sharrows**

Replacement of sharrow markings and signage on Forney Avenue and Park Avenue
