
# **Twenty-Year Plan**

The plan graphic at left illustrates the capital projects targeted for the next twenty years. These include a mix of new academic, housing and support facilities and improvements to open spaces and bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

## **Buildings**

#### **Classroom Building**

New multistory classroom building adjacent to the central quadrangle

#### **Classroom and Laboratory Building**

New academic building with laboratory spaces for science and engineering on the former site of Wallace Hall

#### First Year Housing Phase 2

Two new first-year dormitory buildings in the north residential village with parking and residential quad

#### **Specialty Housing**

Housing development with associated parking west of Salls Hall targeted for sorority and other group use

#### **Specialty Housing**

Continued development of fraternity and other group housing in Paul Carpenter Village

#### **Public Safety Center**


New building to house University Police jointly with a city fire station and new headquarters for Calhoun County Emergency Management Administration

#### **Hotel and Conference Center**

Hotel and conference center potentially located along Mountain Street as a catalyst for the proposed entertainment district

#### **South Campus**

Renovation of Brookstone Building for additional nursing programs





### **Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities**

#### West Campus Shared Path Phase 2

Extension of shared path from Chief Ladiga Trail to athletic complex and west campus housing

#### Pedestrian connector

Pedestrian path connecting from Mountain Street to the Kitty Stone complex in conjunction with development of the hotel and conference center

#### **Chief Ladiga connector**

Bicycle-pedestrian connection from Chief Ladiga Trail to Stone Center with sidewalks and sharrows along 11th Street

#### **North Campus Shared Path**

Improvements to create a connected shared path from the North Residential Village to Stone Center



## **Open Space**

#### Intramural fields

Development of multiple intramural fields along Mountain Street

#### Track renovation

Renovations to existing track facility including new building

#### **Tailgate expansion**

Demolition of existing building services building to expand recreational vehicle tailgate area

#### Angle Hall Lawn

Seating, perimeter walkways and other open space improvements to the main campus lawn

#### **Fitzpatrick Commons**

Tiered seating and other improvements featuring an NPHC Garden making greater use of the sloping back lawn area

#### **Gateway improvements**

Relocation of Fleet Services and beautification of highprofile site with campus signage including improvements to adjacent bicycle-pedestrian path link

#### **Outdoor Recreation area**

Improvement of 13-acre hilltop site for varied outdoor recreation uses, e.g., disc golf, ropes course, walking and biking trail, etc.
