







# **Undergraduate**

**7,918** undergraduate students make up **84**% of JSU's total enrollment.











## **Graduate**

1,563 graduate students make up 16% of JSU's total enrollment.








#### **First-Time Freshmen**



#### **Gender, First-Time Freshmen**





#### **Gender, International Students**





**Gender, Distance Education** 




