




Enrollment by School and Status



Enrollment by Status




Enrollment by Gender




Undergraduate Enrollment 6,695

Undergraduate students make up 87% of JSU's total Spring 2018 enrollment.




Graduate Enrollment 1,001

Graduate students make up **13**% of JSU's total Spring 2018 enrollment.




Distance Education
