

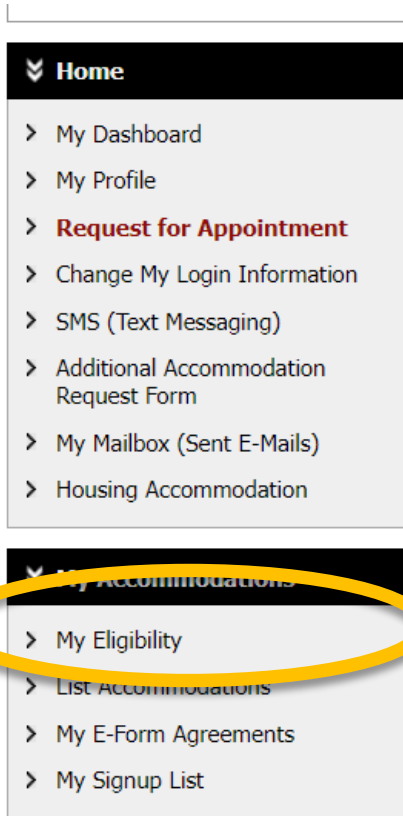

1. Alternative Testing

- **Extra Time 1.50x**

The student should receive 50% extra time (or time and a half) for timed exams. This extra time does not apply to untimed take home exams. For example, if it takes 30 minutes to complete the assessment, the student would have 45 minutes.

- **May Use Testing Center For Proctoring**

The preferred method for exams or testing modifications is to use the Testing Center, if possible. This allows the student to have access to you or a proctor. If the student does not use the Testing Center, the student must use the Testing Center to take their exam. If the specific accommodations met, proctoring can be arranged. The Testing Center Services serves as a resource to JSU students and faculty. If accommodations are not able to be met in the original testing location, please contact testingservices@jsu.edu. Please arrange for testing at the Testing Center.

- **Reduced Distraction Environment**

The student should be provided a room with reduced distraction and visual distraction.

- **Scantron Assistance / Permission to Mark Directly**

The student has permission to mark directly on the exam. The student is not to write the answers onto the Scantron form.

2. Attendance and Deadline Modification

- Login to your AIM Student Portal.
- Click “*My Eligibility*”
- You will see each accommodation that you are eligible for and a description of that accommodation. This is the same name and description that is sent out to your faculty members on your IPPs (Faculty Notification Letters).
