Dr. Staci Stone came to JSU in 2018 as
Dean of the School of Arts and
Humanities (now College of Arts,
Humanities, and Sciences) after 18 years
of teaching and administrative experience
at Murray State University. In 2023, Dr.
Stone was named Vice Provost of
Academic Affairs overseeing numerous
offices including Online@JSU, Faculty
Commons, Dual Enrollment, Sponsored
Programs, Institutional Research and
Effectiveness, and the International
House.

Dr. Timothy King has been at JSU for 16 years, serving the university in various capacities. In 2020, Dr. King was named the Vice Provost for Student Success and has played an integral role in establishing and growing the Student Success Center, which includes academic support, academic advising, testing services, disability support services, first and second-year support, and student athlete support.

Dr. Overton started his tenure at JSU in 2014. During his career, he has served as a Collegiate Athletic Director and as a Collegiate Dean. Dr. Overton has published over 60 articles, authored over a dozen sport manuals, delivered over 40 presentations, and lectured in six continents. He has initiated and collaborated on International Memorandum of Understandings and developed Sport Management programs at five different institutions. Recently, his Graduate Sport Management program at JSU was ranked the best public institution in the United States.




